Launching the Sixties Kit!

We make it easy for you and your program groups to go back to remember that decade of happenings with our **Remembering the Sixties** kit.

You can choose any of four features to watch on the **DVD** by clicking on the *TV Guide* cover featuring *JFK*, *War*, *Science*, or *Justice*. Or choose the fifth option: click on *Surfing* and get a taste of sports, kids, fashion, music, food, movies, alternative programming, and, of course, some sponsors of that decade. You can always expect English captions for those who are deaf or hearing-impaired, but now, for the first time, you can also choose **Spanish subtitles!**

The **CD** features a sing-along led by Pete Seeger in 1965: “Turn, Turn, Turn,” “If I Had A Hammer,” “Guantanamera,” and “This Land Is Your Land.” Then select from 15 tracks with excerpts from speeches and TV from the decade

The lyrics for the sing-along songs are in the large-print **booklet**, but not the music scores for these familiar tunes. That gave us space for more large-format photographs, Top 40 Hits, and Best-Selling Authors.

The twelve photos in the **picture set** will prompt discussion of big news (Freedom Rides, JFK assassination, Vietnam War, and the Moon Landing) and of everyday lives (women working, food, fashions, health and a soapbox derby in the neighborhood).
